
## Description

All the reports that Blanco products generate include digital signatures.

The digital signatures are to be verified by Blanco Cloud or Blanco Management Console so that users can identify tampered reports.


## Step by step instructions

1. Login to Blanco Cloud or Blanco Management Console.
2. Navigate to "Reporting".
3. Select one of DEFAULT VIEWS in which you are interested. For example, "Computer reports" view.
4. Find "report verification" field in the view where "false" and "true" mean "report is tampered" and "report is not tampered" respectively.
