

# How do I boot up the Blancco Driver Eraser?

Once the ISO has been configured if needed ([Drive Eraser Configuration Tool](#)) and loaded onto a CD or a bootable USB drive ([USB Creator](#)). Insert your CD or bootable USB media with the Blancco Drive Eraser software and turn on/reboot your computer.

Make sure that you have set the primary boot device to CD-ROM (optical device) or USB, or have selected the correct boot device from the boot menu. The following article may assist you in this process - [Accessing the BIOS and changing the boot sequence](#)

If the Blancco Erasure Software does not start (or the system boots to an existing operating system) make sure that you have created the bootable media correctly.
